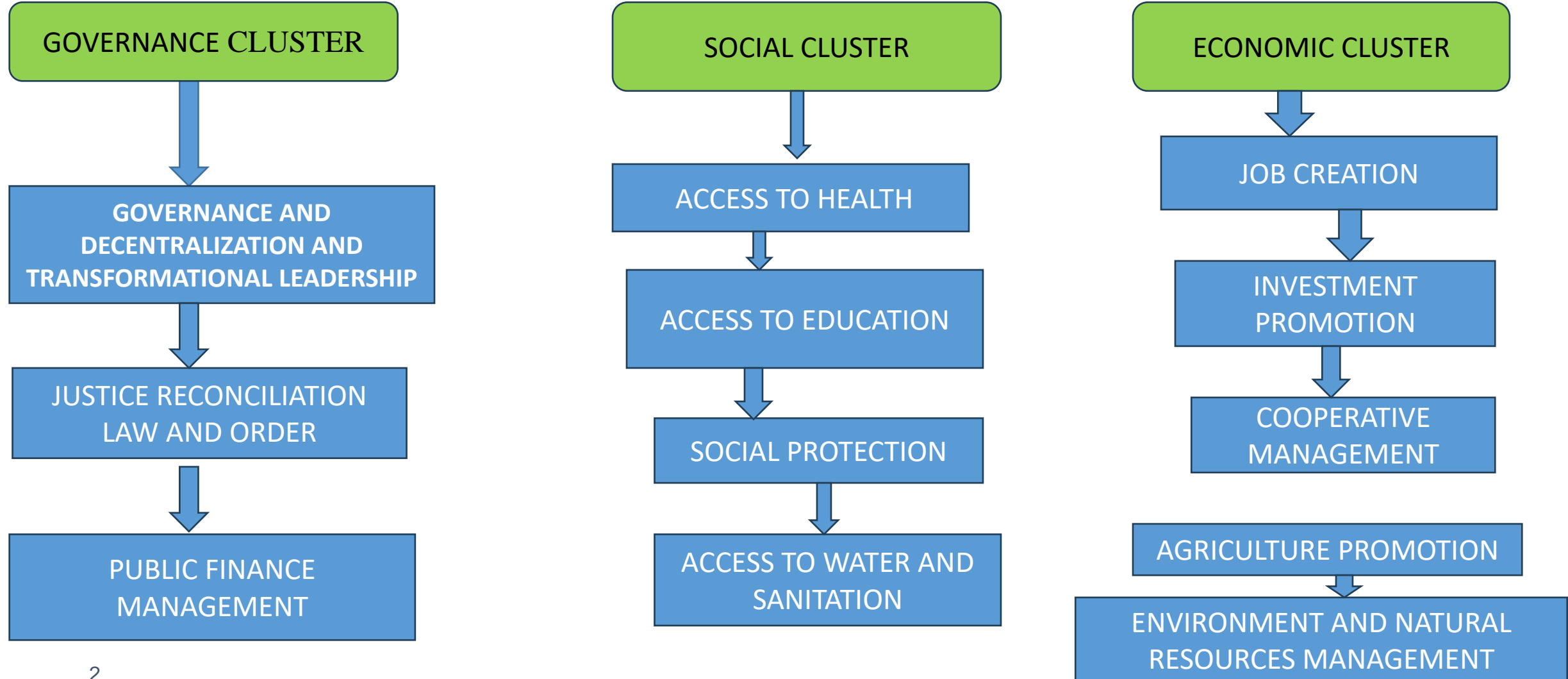

- ❑ Households in graduation process, **22,702 HHs** the budget of social protection, **2,900,088,694**
- ❑ Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all, targets we have in education and the allocated budget is **20,447,317,690**
- ❑ Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all targets of access to clean water, **1000 HHs in their home and 5000 HHs less than 500 m**, budget allocated is **299,059,730**
